- 1. Doris Hodes, Lake County Health Dept.:** Questions on the cornerstone Modernization project; Framework. a) Any update on the project? B) Was the RFP submitted to the US Dept. of Health and Human Services as per schedule? c) Do the requirements take into consideration to allow for an electronic data in an electronic health record or electronic medial record? If so, what format would they be using, e.g. HL7, comma-delimited, etc. What interface engine would it utilize? Would any engine be sufficient or will it be a custom one that agencies must use having limited capabilities? It's not too early to think about this and plan it at this stage of preimplementation.

ANSWER: All of the above are being addressed, still in the planning stages, no new information to give at this time.

- 2. Doris Hodes, Lake County Health Dept.** When the WIC Okidata printers be replaced? Is there a deployment schedule?

ANSWER: There is a deployment schedule and you can call Kellie Blaise for that schedule.

- 3. Yvonne Vieregge, Randolph County Health Dept.;** We just had Okidata refresh and we have an issue that we would like to forward to CUG: We can not see the numbers n the FI when it is in printer ready to print, the white rollers cover them, is there anything we can to and/or change in print program that will allow us to have numbers visible?

ANSWER: You need to use the tear button 2 times.

4. **Julie Sharp, Kane Co.;** With regard to immunizations, we have and are using the medically and religiously contraindicated codes on PA12 when appropriate. Is it possible to have a code for those cases when parents are refusing immunizations for non-religious or non-medical reasons? We do our best to educate these parents, but some absolutely refuse certain vaccines, or immunizations altogether

ANSWER: Per Karen McMahan since the only recognized exemptions for attendance in day care, school or college are for religious and medical, we intend to maintain consistency with utilizing only those. In Illinois, a religious objection is very broad based and most parents' refusals will be classified as that once they enter one of the institutional sites.

5. **Patty Patton, Crawford County;** I anyone having problems on the PA03 (participant enrollment) screen with the residential code? The clerk will pull up the F1 help for domiciled and hit enter thinking it auto popped up and when the client gets back to the nurse the residential code is not there. It does not happen all the time.

ANSWER: Per Debra Phillips they will look at this problem.

6. **Janine Matthews, Moultrie County;** In the cornerstone scheduling area how do you reserve time for like "nurse of day time" that is different everyday depending on the nurses and time for like lunch times for more than one person? For the whole year??

ANSWER: Advised Janine to call Laurie Roxworthy, Will County for this information.

7. **Cindy Hanley, Cumberland Health Dept.;** a) At the AD06 screen can we print that screen out? Can we delete old lot #'s? It would be nice if the whole line would be highlighted there. Is there any way for it to show WFC doses and private stock differently? Especially for reports? b) Is there any way to enter someone who refuses to sign a cornerstone consent waiver so our stock will match? c) RP01 screen – would be nice to run all of one specific vaccine and not all or them. Is there a way?

ANSWER: Shift F10 will print the AD06 screen. Lot numbers cannot be deleted. Highlighting the entire line will require rewriting the screen in FoxPro and is not going to happen at this time. The development staff is looking at the possibility of showing VFC and private stock differently. You can use adjustments for a client that refuses to sign cornerstone consent. There is not a way to run one specific vaccine at this time.

8. Shelley Tulipana, Sangamon County; a) Immunization, could we try and find out why when we give Adacel and document it in Cornerstone then Boostrix shows up on the same day. b) WIC we piloted the new version and since we have been using it when a child comes in for a 2 year cert before being actually 2 years old we are not able to enter appropriate food packages. For example say a 234 month old comes in for a cert. We put in a service entry of WCC1. This child should receive toddler food package for 1 month and then a child food package after that. We are unable to enter the child food package without putting in a second service entry for WCC2. Is this right?

ANSWER: They are working on fixing the Medicaid import for this reason. You should certify the client as a WCC2 which is what they are there for. The application is working as it should.

9. Doris Hodes, Lake County Health Dept.; HSPR0747 Family Case Management participant Risk Report Can subtotal/total counts be added:

- after each at risk group
- after each not at risk group
- total for case manager (sum of a+b)
- Grand total (sum of all c's)

ANSWER: Yes to all of the above

10. Karla Burress, Tazewell County Health; I really think that the confidential case note that is written for the EPDS should be able to be viewed by the supervisor and assigned CM. The EPDS screening could be done in WIC by the WIC nurse and that WIC nurse who can go back in to view the case note will never need to go view it again because the person that is going to follow up on that mom is the assigned CM and that assigned CM is not able to view the note and therefore she unable to have the knowledge of what has already been done and how to follow up. So I think for continuity of care, the supervisor and the assigned CM should be able to see the note. Is there anyway that this can be changes?

ANSWER: The PP Depression is a confidential case note and should be print screened to Case Manager and referred.

Discussion Items:

Version 12 will be out next. There will not be many changes for users. Some Foxfire changes

There has been some money received and will be used to merge agencies with multiple sites to merge together and have only 1 server. The goal for this to begin is the end of February. They money has to be spent by September 30, 2010.

The next version has a goal of the end of the Fiscal year, the first of July.

Stephanie Bess, WIC will continue to get more information of the code WTE and get back to the users.

Per Debra Phillips the birth screen will have to be changed back to adding over 13. This screen is used for DCFS and EI. When asking for a screen change we need to make sure that these changes do not affect other programs. Making changes and then having to change them back is not acceptable.
