JULY 28, 2010**

- 1. Julie Sharp, Kane Co.:** Reference #413259: A question rose regarding forecasting immunizations which led to the ticket referenced above, and we learned that the immunization for Rotavirus is not part of forecasting. Are other immunizations that are not part of forecasting? Is there any way that all immunizations could be part of forecasting?

- 2. Christine Johnson, Winnebago County Health Dept.:** Is it possible to implement an F1 (help) option on the AS01/FHH Assessment on questions #12 for the fields LMP and EDC? (Similar to the Postpartum Data screen/PA10 where we can push F1 for Prenatal EDC field and it fills it in for us).

- 3. Suzi Waters, Adams County Health Dept:** Sometimes when we gave a Tdap (Adacel) the next day Tdap (Boostrix) is also on the client record; can this be fixed to avoid confusion?

- 4. Linda Ervin, Jasper Health Dept.;** I'm not sure if we have discussed this before and I have forgotten or if no one else is having problems with it. We are not receiving case findings if the client is currently on a medical card and gets pregnant. We are not notified that they are pregnant until the client calls and in many cases the client is already well into here pregnancy if not ready to deliver before we find out.

5. Cindy Hanley, Cumberland Health Dept.; 1) would it be possible for the day of the week to show up under the date on the SC02 screen? 2) When a client no longer receives medical card can that number be removed from PA02? 3) On SV04 (staff time entry) could we have a comments box to put in an explanation of the time if we want to. (If we list 8 hours under 400, we could put in the comments that it was RS, PTO, or flex time)

6. Doris Hodes, Lake County Health Dept.; 1) Are there any updates you can provide on the Cornerstone Modernization project; Framework? 2) Issue searching the PA01 using a clients Also Know As name: **a)** search local AKA name + 1st initial (first name) + DOB; no records found. **b)** Search local with AKA Name + 1st initial (first name) + no DIB; ctrl-J client not listed **c)** Search statewide from above screen (ESC= State, Ctrl-J); client now listed, at our clinic. **d)** Note: Any local searches done with client's actual Last name are able to find client okay. On HT#414183 we were told: This is because the AKA was entered by another agency. When they add the AKA, it adds it to their PARTSNDX table, but when record transfers to us, our PARTSNDX isn't updated. When these are found, we should just to F6=Edit/F4=Save to update our PARTSNDX table. Can the transfer process be changed so when a transfer occurs, the requesting agencies PARTSNDX are also updated? This would help avoid creating duplicates and staff confusion when trying to locate the correct client when the client isn't found locally. 3) Can the version letters for V11.81 and V12.0 (split ASSMRSLT file) be posted on the Cornerstone website (<http://www.cstonesupport.info/user/version.htm>)? That way the list would be complete, and a single reference point for agencies of when changes were put in place
