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# Cornerstone Version 8.52 Changes

## ATTENTION!! IMPORTANT VERSION INFORMATION!

Beginning with the full release of version 8.52 (non-pilot), it is imperative that each site has ALL laptops in an "Upload" status prior to receiving the "live" version. This major change is being implemented to alleviate the hours of work spent by the Cornerstone Development and Support teams when laptops are not uploaded prior to a new version release.

From this version release forward, unless every laptop at your site is in the upload status, your site will not receive the new version. **Not only will your site not receive the new version, but Cornerstone will be disabled COMPLETELY.** There will be NO EXCEPTIONS to this policy. As a precaution, your site may want to have all laptops checked in Thursday prior to a version release to ensure no last minute problems arise.

There will be NO access to Cornerstone at all until the unresolved laptops are at the site and ready for upload. At that time, you can contact the Cornerstone Call Center to begin the process of getting your site updated and running again.

*Please be aware that this process will take a minimum of 3 hours from the time you are contacted. This is only an estimate and it may take longer for your site.*

In preparation for this change in procedures, we ran a cleanup in November to delete old laptop records. We suggest you run the Laptops Currently Downloaded (HSPR0405) report to check current laptop statuses. If you are unsure of your laptop statuses or need some resolved, contact the Cornerstone Call Center for assistance at toll-free 1-877-447-4221.

## General Changes

- The **Assessment screen (AS01)** has been modified to reflect the following changes:
  - The questions have been modified to allow comments to be made for a question regardless if the question has been answered. Previously, comments could not be entered if the question had not been answered.
  - The questions have been modified to group together on the same screen. Previously, some questions split between two screens.
  - Users can now view comments without being in "F5-Add" or "F6-Edit" mode. Users will be able to view comments by placing the cursor in the comment field and typing a "C" or "X" in the field to view the comment.
  - The screen has been enhanced to allow the user to enter a participant on the assessment screen, and to inquire on an assessment in a more timely manner.
  - The screen will no longer display inactive questions, even if the question was previously answered.
- The **Assessment History report (HSPR0207)** has been modified to display the entire comment entered in assessments. Previously, this report would only print the first 65 characters of the comment. The report has also been modified to no longer display inactive questions, even if the question was previously answered.
- When the pilot Version 8.52p was released in October 2003, 13 **Cornerstone reports** were modified, resulting in cosmetic changes. These 13 reports have been reverted back to their original formatting.
- The **Group Browse function** within the Group Member pop-up box has been modified. Previously, an error message was occasionally generated when performing a group browse. The pop-up box was modified to help eliminate these errors. If you still receive any errors, please call the Cornerstone Call Center at toll-free (877) 447-4221 / (877)-41PHCA1.

## Breast and Cervical Cancer Program (BCCP)

- The **BCCP-Summary Statistics report (HSPR0784)** is being temporarily disabled until the release of Cornerstone version 9.0 in mid 2004. The HSPR0784 reports will be run in Springfield and forwarded to each IBCCP agency once a month. Specific information about this change will be forthcoming from program staff by January 20th.

- The **“RACE” assessment** [accessed from the Assessment screen (AS01)] has been modified. The category of “6 – Other” has been removed from the selections and the category codes have been re-numbered. The following are the Race categories:
  - 1 - White
  - 2 - Black or African American
  - 3 - Asian
  - 4 - Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islanders
  - 5 - American Indian or Alaskan Native
  - 6 - Unknown

### **Early Intervention (EI)**

- The majority of the modifications in version 8.52 reflect changes required under new **HIPAA Regulations**. The EI program will provide the specific changes under a separate addendum.
- Cornerstone has been modified to close the Early Intervention Program Data (PA35) record when a participant is **automatically terminated**.
- The **EI Authorized Provider Services Report (HSPR0771)** has been modified to address printing issues. The print screen has been modified to allow the user to select the printer to which the report will print. This process is identical to the one currently being used when running the EI Service Plan Report (HSPR0777) and the EI Family Fee Report (HSPR0778).

### **Immunization**

- The **Multiple Immunization Entry screen (PA23)** has been modified to allow users to add immunizations when the shot date equals the lot received date. Previously, if the dates were equal, users were not able to select the lot.
- **Forecasting** has been modified for the new shot Pediarix. The combination vaccine Pediarix (DTap/IPV/HEP B), Cornerstone Immunization Type 32, will count as a shot for the following Cornerstone Immunization Series:
  - 17 - IPV
  - 14 - HEP B – PEDIATRIC
  - 20 - DTAP – ACELLULAR

### **Teen Parent Services**

- The Cornerstone Reference Manual now contains updated information on the Teen Parent Services. Both Chapter 19 “Teen Parent Services” and the screen flows in Appendix A have been updated.

### **WIC**

- The **WIC Education Summary report (HSPR0108)** has been modified to count only completed certifications of participants who were active in the program. Previously, if a participant was in “eligible” status, and then terminated without ever being active, the participant would incorrectly be counted.
